A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to enrollment requirements for the operation of Texas A&M University--San Antonio as a general academic teaching institution 3 and the issuance of bonds for that institution. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 87.841, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, 8 Texas A&M University--San Antonio may not operate as a general 9 academic teaching institution until the Texas Higher Education 10 11 Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the Texas A&M 12 University--Kingsville System Center--San Antonio has reached an enrollment equivalent of[+ 13 14 [(1)] 1,000 full-time students for one semester [if the legislature authorizes revenue bonds to be issued to finance 15 educational and related facilities for the institution, and the 16 17 bonds are issued for that purpose; or 18 [(2) 2,500 full-time students for one semester if the conditions specified by Subdivision (1) are not satisfied]. 19 20 SECTION 2. Subsection (e), Section 55.1751, Education Code, 21 is amended to read as follows:

(e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), The Texas A&M
University System may not issue bonds under this section for
facilities at Texas A&M University--San Antonio until the Texas

Higher Education Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at Texas A&M University--San Antonio has reached an enrollment equivalent of <u>1,000</u> [1,500] full-time students for one semester. [If that enrollment is not reached by January 1, 2010, the system's authority to issue bonds for Texas A&M University--San Antonio under this section expires on that date.]

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each House, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
