## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to school bus emergency evacuation training.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 34.0021(a) and (b), Education Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A [Pursuant to the safety standards established by the
- 7 Department of Public Safety under Section 34.002, each] school
- 8 district <u>may elect to [shall</u>] conduct [a] training [session] for
- 9 students and teachers concerning procedures for evacuating a school
- 10 bus during an emergency.
- 11 (b) A school district that elects to conduct the school bus
- 12 <a href="mailto:emergency evacuation training">emergency evacuation training</a> shall conduct the [school bus
- 13 emergency evacuation] training in compliance with the safety
- 14 standards established by the Department of Public Safety under
- 15 Section 34.002 [at least twice each school year, with one training
- 16 session occurring in the fall and one training session occurring in
- 17 the spring. A portion of the training session must occur on a
- 18 school bus and the training session must last for at least one
- 19 <u>hour</u>].
- SECTION 2. Sections 34.0021(d) and (e), Education Code, are
- 21 repealed.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
