- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is 5

- Sec. 11.174. CAMPUS CLOSURE. (a) Before ordering the 7
- closure of a school campus, the board of trustees of a school 8

- district may comment on the proposed closure. 10
- 11 (b) Not later than the seventh day before the date of the
- 12 hearing, the board must:
- 13 (1) provide written notice of the hearing to the
- 14 parent of or person standing in parental relation to each student
- affected by the closure; and 15
- (2) publish notice of the hearing in a newspaper of 16
- general circulation in the district. 17
- 18 (c) The notice of the hearing required by Subsection (b)

- (1) the subject matter of the hearing, including the 20
- 21 reason for the proposed closure; and
- 22 (2) the location, date, and time of the hearing.
- 23 (d) Following a hearing under Subsection (a), the board
- shall vote on the proposed closure. If the board votes to close a 24

- 1 school campus, the board shall send the results of the vote to the
- 2 commissioner for approval.
- 3 (e) The board may not order the closure of a school campus
- 4 without first obtaining the approval of the commissioner for the
- 5 <u>closure.</u>
- 6 <u>(f) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 7 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
