A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to limits on the size of public school classes in prekindergarten, kindergarten, and grades one through four. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 25.112(a) and (d), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 (a) Except as otherwise authorized by this section, a school 7 district may not enroll more than 22 students in a prekindergarten, 8 kindergarten, first, second, third, or fourth grade class. 9 That limitation does not apply during: 10 (1) any 12-week period of the school year selected by 11 12 the district, in the case of a district whose average daily attendance is adjusted under Section 42.005(c); or 13 14 (2) the last 12 weeks of any school year in the case of any other district. 15 On application of a school district for a campus, the 16 (d) commissioner may except the campus [district] from the limit in 17 Subsection (a) if the commissioner finds the limit works an undue 18 hardship on the campus [district]. An exception expires at the end 19 of the semester for which it is granted, and the commissioner may 20 21 not grant <u>a campus</u> an exception for: (1) more than one semester at a time; or 22 23 (2) more than two semesters in a three-year period.

24 SECTION 2. Section 25.112, Education Code, as amended by

this Act, applies beginning with the 2009-2010 school year. For purposes of Section 25.112(d), Education Code, as amended by this Act, an exception granted to a campus under that subsection as it existed before amendment by this Act for the 2007-2008 or 2008-2009 school year is included in determining the eligibility of the campus for an exception in the 2009-2010 or 2010-2011 school year.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
