- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 604, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

## 6 SUBCHAPTER D. PROHIBITED RESTRICTIONS

- 7 Sec. 604.151. EXPIRATION OF STORED VALUE CARD PROHIBITED.
- 8 A person may not issue or sell a stored value card that provides
- 9 that the card expires after a certain date. A condition providing
- 10 for the expiration of a stored value card is void.
- 11 SECTION 2. Sections 604.002, 604.051, 604.101, 604.102, and
- 12 604.103, Business & Commerce Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 604.002. INAPPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
- 14 does not apply to a stored value card [that]:
- 15 (1) that is issued by:
- 16 (A) a financial institution acting as a financial
- 17 agent of the United States or this state;
- 18 (B) a federally insured financial institution,
- 19 as defined by Section 201.101, Finance Code, if the financial
- 20 institution is primarily liable for the card as the issuing
- 21 principal; or
- (C) an air carrier holding a certificate of
- 23 public convenience and necessity under Title 49, United States
- 24 Code;

- 1 (2) that is issued as a prepaid calling card by a
- 2 prepaid calling card company regulated under Section 55.253,
- 3 Utilities Code;
- 4 (3) that is distributed by the issuer to a person under
- 5 an awards, rewards, loyalty, incentive, rebate, or promotional
- 6 program and is not issued or reloaded in exchange for money tendered
- 7 by the cardholder;
- 8 (4) that is sold below face value or donated to:
- 9 (A) an employee of the seller or issuer;
- 10 (B) a nonprofit or charitable organization; or
- 11 (C) an educational institution for fund-raising
- 12 purposes; or
- 13 (5) [does not expire and] for which the seller does not
- 14 charge a fee other than a fee described in Section 604.051.
- 15 Sec. 604.051. FEES AND CHARGES RELATED TO ISSUANCE AND
- 16 HANDLING OF CARD. If disclosed as required by Subchapter C, the
- 17 issuer of a stored value card may impose and collect a reasonable:
- 18 (1) handling fee in connection with the issuance of or
- 19 adding of value to the card;
- 20 (2) access fee for a card transaction conducted at an
- 21 unmanned teller machine, as defined by Section 59.301, Finance
- 22 Code; and
- 23 (3) reissue or replacement charge if  $\underline{a}$  [an expired or]
- 24 lost card is reissued or replaced.
- Sec. 604.101. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN MATTERS
- 26 APPLICABLE TO CARD. A [An expiration date or] policy, fee, or other
- 27 material restriction or contract term applicable to a stored value

- 1 card must be clearly and conspicuously disclosed at the time the
- 2 card is sold or issued to a person to enable the person to make an
- 3 informed decision before purchasing the card.
- 4 Sec. 604.102. REQUIRED PRINTING OF CERTAIN DISCLOSURES. In
- 5 addition to the disclosure required under Section 604.101, a
- 6 disclosure regarding [the expiration of a stored value card or] a
- 7 periodic fee that reduces the unredeemed value of a stored value
- 8 card must be legibly printed on the card.
- 9 Sec. 604.103. VALIDITY OF CARD SOLD WITHOUT REQUIRED
- 10 DISCLOSURES. A stored value card sold without the disclosure
- 11 required by this subchapter of  $\underline{a}$  [an expiration date or] policy,
- 12 fee, or other material restriction or contract term applicable to
- 13 the card is valid until redeemed or replaced.
- SECTION 3. Section 72.1016(b), Property Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (b) If the existence and location of the owner of a stored
- 17 value card is unknown to the holder of the property, the stored
- 18 value card is presumed abandoned to the extent of its unredeemed and
- 19 uncharged value on the earlier of:
- 20 (1) [the card's expiration date;
- 21  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the third anniversary of the date the card was
- 22 issued, if the card is not used after it is issued, or the date the
- 23 card was last used or value was last added to the card; or
- (2) [<del>(3)</del>] the first anniversary of the date the card
- 25 was issued, if the card is not used after it is issued, or the date
- 26 the card was last used or value was last added to the card, if the
- 27 card's value represents wages, as defined by Section 61.001, Labor

- 1 Code.
- 2 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 the issuance or sale of a stored value card on or after the
- 4 effective date of this Act. The issuance or sale of a stored value
- 5 card before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 6 effect when the card was issued or sold, and the former law is
- 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
