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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended 6
- 7 by adding Section 13.1395 to read as follows:
- Sec. 13.1395. AUXILIARY EMERGENCY GENERATORS. (a) This 8
- 9 section applies only to a retail public utility required to possess
- a certificate of convenience and necessity, and a district or 10
- affected county, that provide retail water or sewer utility service 11
- to more than 1,000 customers in a county that is assigned a risk 12
- designation of "high" or "very high" under Subsection (b). 13
- 14 (b) The commission by rule shall assign each county in this
- state a level of risk of "low," "moderate," "high," or "very high" 15
- according to that county's likelihood of experiencing a major 16
- disaster, based on historical information regarding the number of 17
- federal disaster declarations that have been declared for the 18
- 19 county.
- (c) A retail public utility, district, or affected county to 20
- 21 which this section applies shall incorporate and maintain on-site
- automatically starting auxiliary generators capable of ensuring 22
- the operation of the utility's water and sewer systems in a county 23
- that is assigned a risk designation of "high" or "very high" under 24

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- 1 Subsection (b) during an <u>extended power outage caused by a major</u>
- 2 disaster.
- 3 (d) The commission by rule shall establish the minimum
- 4 operating standards for auxiliary generators required by
- 5 Subsection (c), which must include the minimum length of time and
- 6 minimum operating capacity auxiliary generators must maintain
- 7 <u>during an extended power outage.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2009, the Texas
- 9 Commission on Environmental Quality by rule shall adopt standards
- 10 as required by Section 13.1395, Water Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. A retail public utility, district, or affected
- 12 county required to incorporate and maintain an auxiliary generator
- 13 under Section 13.1395, Water Code, as added by this Act, shall
- 14 comply with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality rules adopted
- 15 under that section not later than January 31, 2010.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
