## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 112, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 112.011 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 112.011. SEARCHABLE COUNTY EXPENDITURE DATABASE. (a)
8	This section applies to a county with a population of 20,000 or
9	more.
10	(b) The commissioners court of a county shall establish and
11	post on the Internet a database of county expenditures that is
12	electronically searchable by the public except as provided by
13	Subsection (d). The database must include:
14	(1) the amount, date, payor, and payee of
15	<pre>expenditures; and</pre>
16	(2) a listing of county expenditures by:
17	(A) object of expense with links to the warrant
18	or check register level; and
19	(B) to the extent maintained by county accounting
20	systems in a reportable format, class and item levels.
21	(c) To the extent possible, the county shall present
22	information in the database established under this section in a
23	manner that is searchable and intuitive to users. The county shall

enhance and organize the presentation of the information through

- 1 the use of graphical representations, such as pie charts, as the
- 2 county considers appropriate. At a minimum, the database must
- 3 allow users to:
- 4 (1) search and aggregate county funding by any element
- 5 of the information;
- 6 (2) ascertain through a single search the total amount
- 7 of county funding awarded to a person by the county; and
- 8 (3) download information yielded by a search of the
- 9 database.
- 10 (d) The county may not allow public access under this
- 11 section to a payee's address, except that the county may allow
- 12 public access under this section to information identifying the
- 13 county in which the payee is located. The county may not allow
- 14 public access under this section to information that is identified
- 15 by the county as excepted from required disclosure under Chapter
- 16 552, Government Code, or as confidential.
- 17 (e) The county may not charge a fee to the public to access
- 18 the database.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 112.011, Local Government Code, as added
- 20 by this Act, applies only to expenditures made on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
