- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 548.602(c), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)(1)
- 8 that:
- 9 (1) an inspection certificate for the vehicle is in
- 10 effect at the time of the arrest; or
- 11 (2) the defendant provides to the court a receipt
- 12 issued by an inspection station showing that the date of expiration
- 13 <u>designated on the inspection certificate issued for the vehicle is</u>
- 14 incorrect and that the offense charged was alleged to have occurred
- 15 before the fifth day after the correct date of expiration that
- 16 should have been designated on the certificate.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 18 offense under Section 548.602(a)(1), Transportation Code,
- 19 regardless of whether the offense was committed before, on, or
- 20 after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
