- 8 (a) Each school district shall adopt and implement a policy
- 9 addressing sexual abuse of children to be included in the district
- 10 improvement plan under Section 11.252.
- 11 (b) A policy required by this section must address:
- 12 (1) methods for increasing teacher, student, and
- 13 parent awareness of issues regarding sexual abuse of children,
- 14 including knowledge of likely warning signs indicating that a child
- 15 may be a victim of sexual abuse, using resources developed by the
- 16 agency under Section 38.004;
- 17 (2) actions that a child who is a victim of sexual
- 18 abuse should take to obtain assistance and intervention; and
- 19 <u>(3) available counseling options for students</u>
- 20 affected by sexual abuse.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
