5	SECTION 1. Section 659.1031, Government Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 659.1031. DEDUCTION OF MEMBERSHIP FEES FOR ELIGIBLE
8	[STATE EMPLOYEE] ORGANIZATIONS. (a) An employee of a state agency
9	may authorize in writing a deduction each pay period from the
10	employee's salary or wage payment for payment to an eligible [state
11	employee] organization of a membership fee in the organization.
12	(b) In this section, "eligible [state employee]
13	organization" means <u>:</u>
14	(1) a state employee organization with a membership of
15	at least 2,000 active or retired state employees who hold or who
16	have held certification from the Commission on Law Enforcement
17	Officer Standards and Education; or

- 18 (2) a national nonprofit organization with:
- (A) a membership of at least 2,000 active or
- 20 retired state employees who are employed or have been employed by
- 21 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and
- (B) a primary function of preserving and
- 23 supporting the surviving families of correctional officers.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
