- 5 SECTION 1. Section 111.96, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 111.96. ESTABLISHMENT: SCOPE. (a) The board of
- 8 regents shall <u>maintain</u> [<u>establish</u>] an [<u>upper-level</u>] educational
- 9 institution in the City of Victoria to be known as the University of
- 10 Houston-Victoria.
- 11 (b) The institution shall [be organized to] offer
- 12 <u>undergraduate</u> [only junior, senior,] and graduate level programs.
- 13 [(c) The institution may enroll a student who has
- 14 successfully completed at least 30 semester credit hours of course
- 15 work at a public or private institution of higher education and who
- 16 is concurrently enrolled in another public or private institution
- 17 of higher education.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
