A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the board of trustees of the Teacher
- 3 Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (5) "Board of trustees" means the <u>persons</u> [board]
- 8 appointed or elected under this subtitle to administer the
- 9 retirement system.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 825.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 825.002. <u>APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF</u> TRUSTEES
- 13 [APPOINTED BY GOVERNOR]. (a) The governor shall appoint, with the
- 14 advice and consent of the senate [and as provided by this section],
- 15 [seven members of the board of trustees.
- 16 [(b) The governor shall appoint] three <u>trustees</u> [members]
- 17 of the board of trustees to hold office for staggered terms, with
- 18 the term of one trustee expiring on August 31 of each odd-numbered
- 19 year. These $\underline{\text{trustees}}$ [$\underline{\text{members}}$] must be persons who have
- 20 demonstrated financial expertise, who have worked in private
- 21 business or industry, and who have broad investment experience,
- 22 preferably in investment of pension funds. None of the trustees
- 23 [members] appointed under this subsection may be a member or
- 24 annuitant of the retirement system.

- (b) Two trustees who are [(c) The governor shall appoint 1 two members of the board from a slate of three] members of the 2 3 retirement system and who are currently employed by a public school district shall be elected [and who have been nominated in 4 accordance with Subsection (f)] by the members of the retirement 5 system whose most recent credited service was performed for a 6 public school district. The two trustees [members] hold office for 7 8 staggered terms.
- 9 (c) One trustee who is a [(d) The governor shall appoint one
 10 member of the board from a slate of three] former member [members]
 11 of the retirement system, has [who have] retired, and is [are]
 12 receiving benefits from the retirement system shall be elected [and
 13 who have been nominated in accordance with Subsections (f) and (g)]
 14 by [the] persons who have retired and are receiving benefits from
 15 the retirement system.
- 16 <u>(d) One trustee who is a member [(e) The governor shall</u>
 17 appoint one member from a slate of three members] of the retirement
 18 system and who is [are currently] employed by an institution of
 19 higher education shall be elected [and who have been nominated in
 20 accordance with Subsection (f)] by the members of the retirement
 21 system whose most recent credited service was performed for an
 22 institution of higher education.
- (e) The board of trustees shall adopt rules for the election
 of trustees described [(f) Persons considered for nomination]
 under Subsection (b), (c), or (d)[, or (e) must have been nominated
 by written ballot at an election conducted under rules adopted by
 the board of trustees].

- 1 (f) [(g)] To provide for the election [nomination of
- 2 persons for appointment] under Subsection (c) (d), the board of
- 3 trustees shall send to each retiree of the retirement system:
- 4 (1) notice of the deadline for filing as a candidate
- 5 for election [nomination];
- 6 (2) information on procedures to follow in filing as a
- 7 candidate; and
- 8 (3) a [written] ballot.
- 9 SECTION 3. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 10 are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 12 eligible for appointment or election to the board of trustees if the
- 13 person or the person's spouse:
- 14 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 15 of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 16 retirement system;
- 17 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 18 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 19 organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 20 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 21 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 22 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board of
- 23 <u>trustees</u> membership, attendance, or expenses.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 25 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 26 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 27 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who

- 1 is <u>elected</u> [nominated for appointment] under Section 825.002(b)
- 2 [825.002(c)], (c), or (d)[-or(e)].
- 3 SECTION 4. Sections 825.0041(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 4 are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) A person who is appointed or elected to and qualifies
- 6 for office as a member of the board of trustees may not vote,
- 7 deliberate, or be counted as a member in attendance at a meeting of
- 8 the board until the person completes a training program that
- 9 complies with this section.
- 10 (c) A person appointed or elected to the board of trustees
- 11 is entitled to reimbursement under Section 825.007 for the travel
- 12 expenses incurred in attending the training program regardless of
- 13 whether the attendance at the program occurs before or after
- 14 the person qualifies for office.
- SECTION 5. Section 825.009(a), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (a) A trustee elected [appointed from a slate of members
- 18 nominated] by members of the retirement system under Section
- 19 825.002 is entitled to leave with pay from the trustee's public
- 20 school employer to attend to the official business of the
- 21 retirement system.
- SECTION 6. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 23 are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board of trustees
- 25 that a trustee:
- 26 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 27 qualifications required for the trustee's position;

- 1 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 2 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 3 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 4 825.002(a) [825.002(b)] or 825.0032 applicable to the trustee;
- 5 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge
- 6 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which
- 7 the trustee is appointed or elected; or
- 8 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 9 scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to attend
- 10 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote
- 11 of the board.
- 12 (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential
- 13 ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the
- 14 presiding officer of the board of trustees of the ground. The
- 15 presiding officer shall then notify the governor [appropriate
- 16 appointing officer] and the attorney general that a potential
- 17 ground for removal exists. If the potential ground for removal
- 18 involves the presiding officer, the executive director shall notify
- 19 the next highest officer of the board, who shall notify the governor
- 20 [appropriate appointing officer] and the attorney general that a
- 21 potential ground for removal exists.
- 22 SECTION 7. (a) This Act applies only to the appointment or
- 23 election of a trustee of the board of trustees of the Teacher
- 24 Retirement System of Texas that occurs on or after the effective
- 25 date of this Act.
- 26 (b) A person who is serving as a trustee immediately before
- 27 the effective date of this Act may complete the trustee's term of

- 1 office, and the trustee's qualifications for serving as a trustee
- 2 are governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 3 date of this Act until the date that trustee's term expires.
- 4 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
