A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the appointment of election judges.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 32.002(a), (b), and (c), Election Code,
- 5 are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The commissioners court at its August [July] term shall
- 7 appoint the election judges for each regular county election
- 8 precinct.
- 9 (b) Judges appointed under Subsection (a) serve for a term
- 10 of one year beginning on September 1 [August 1] following the
- 11 appointment, except that the commissioners court by order recorded
- 12 in its minutes may provide for a term of two years.
- 13 (c) The presiding judge and alternate presiding judge must
- 14 be affiliated or aligned with different political parties, subject
- 15 to this subsection. Before August [July] of each year, the county
- 16 chair of a political party whose candidate for governor received
- 17 the highest or second highest number of votes in the county in the
- 18 most recent gubernatorial general election shall submit in writing
- 19 to the commissioners court a list of names of persons in order of
- 20 preference for each precinct who are eligible for appointment as an
- 21 election judge. The county chair may supplement the list of names
- 22 of persons until the 20th day before a general election or the 15th
- 23 day before a special election in case an appointed election judge
- 24 becomes unable to serve. The commissioners court shall appoint the

- 1 first person meeting the applicable eligibility requirements from
- 2 the list submitted in compliance with this subsection by the party
- 3 with the highest number of votes in the precinct as the presiding
- 4 judge and the first person meeting the applicable eligibility
- 5 requirements from the list submitted in compliance with this
- 6 subsection by the party with the second highest number of votes in
- 7 the precinct as the alternate presiding judge. The commissioners
- 8 court may reject the list if the persons whose names are submitted
- 9 on the list are determined not to meet the applicable eligibility
- 10 requirements.
- 11 SECTION 2. The term of an election judge serving on the
- 12 effective date of this Act expires:
- 13 (1) September 1, 2010, if the judge's term would expire
- 14 August 1, 2010, under Section 32.002(b), Election Code, as that
- 15 section existed before amendment by this Act; or
- 16 (2) September 1, 2011, if the judge's term would expire
- 17 August 1, 2011, under Section 32.002(b), Election Code, as that
- 18 section existed before amendment by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
