- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 142.0015, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (e-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (d), in a municipality
- 8 with a population of one million or more that has not adopted
- 9 Chapter 143, for purposes of determining hours worked, including
- 10 determining hours worked for calculation of overtime under
- 11 Subsection (e), all hours are counted as hours worked during which
- 12 the fire fighter or member of the fire department:
- 13 (1) is required to remain available for immediate call
- 14 to duty by continuously remaining in contact with the fire
- 15 department office by telephone, pager, or radio; or
- 16 (2) is taking any authorized leave, including
- 17 attendance incentive leave, vacation leave, holiday leave,
- 18 compensatory time off, jury duty, military leave, or leave because
- 19 of a death in the family.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
