## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to notice of contract expiration in retail electric

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.112 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.112. NOTICE OF CONTRACT EXPIRATION. (a) In this
- 8 <u>section</u>, "fixed price contract" means a residential retail electric
- 9 service contract for a term of six months or more in which the price
- 10 for each billing period is stated in the contract and does not
- 11 change throughout the term of the contract. The term does not
- 12 include month-to-month service.
- (b) A retail electric provider shall provide a residential
- 14 customer who has a fixed price contract with written notification
- 15 of the date the contract is scheduled to expire. The notice must be
- 16 sent to the customer's billing address by mail postmarked not less
- 17 than 60 days before the date the contract is scheduled to expire.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a contract for retail electric service entered into or renewed on
- 20 or after the effective date of this Act. A contract for retail
- 21 electric service entered into or renewed before the effective date
- 22 of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 23 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
