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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation of propane utility companies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 101.002(b), Utilities Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (b) Gas utilities, including propane utilities, are by 7 definition monopolies in the areas they serve. As a result, the 8 normal forces of competition that regulate prices in a free 9 enterprise society do not operate. Public agencies regulate 10 utility rates, operations, and services as a substitute for 11 competition.

12 SECTION 2. Section 101.003, Utilities Code, is amended by 13 amending Subdivision (7) and adding Subdivision (11-a) to read as 14 follows:

(7) "Gas utility" includes a person or river authority 15 16 that owns or operates for compensation in this state equipment or facilities to transmit or distribute combustible hydrocarbon 17 natural gas or synthetic natural gas for sale or resale in a manner 18 not subject to the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory 19 Commission under the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. Section 717 et 20 seq.). The term includes a lessee, trustee, or receiver of a gas 21 utility. The term includes a propane utility. The term does not 22 23 include:

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(A) a municipal corporation;

No. 1194 1 (B) a person or river authority to the extent the person or river authority: 2 3 (i) produces, gathers, transports, or sells natural gas or synthetic natural gas under Section 121.004 or 4 5 121.005; 6 (ii) distributes sells liquefied or 7 petroleum gas; or 8 (iii) transports, delivers, or sells natural gas for fuel for irrigation wells or any other direct 9 10 agricultural use; a person to the extent the person: 11 (C) 12 (i) sells natural gas for use as vehicle fuel; 13 14 (ii) sells natural gas to a person who later 15 sells the natural gas for use as vehicle fuel; or 16 (iii) owns or operates equipment or 17 facilities to sell or transport natural gas for ultimate use as vehicle fuel; 18 a person not otherwise a gas utility who 19 (D) furnishes gas or gas service only to itself, its employees, or its 20 tenants as an incident of employment or tenancy, if the gas or gas 21 service is not resold to or used by others; or 22 23 (E) a person excluded from being considered a gas 24 utility under Section 121.007. 25 (11-a) "Propane utility" means a person that owns or 26 operates for compensation in this state equipment or facilities to transmit, store, or distribute propane gas for sale or resale. The 27

term includes a lessee, trustee, or receiver of a propane utility. 1 The term does not include a person not otherwise a propane utility 2 who furnishes propane gas <u>service only to itself</u>, its employees, or 3 its tenants as an incident of employment or tenancy, if the propane 4 gas service is not resold or used by others. 5 6 SECTION 3. Section 102.001(a), Utilities Code, is amended 7 to read as follows: 8 (a) The railroad commission has exclusive original jurisdiction over the rates and services of a gas utility: 9 10 (1)that distributes natural gas, propane gas, or synthetic natural gas in: 11 (A) areas outside a municipality; and 12 areas inside a municipality that surrenders 13 (B) 14 its jurisdiction to the railroad commission under Section 103.003; 15 and 16 (2) that transmits, transports, delivers, or sells 17 natural gas, propane gas, or synthetic natural gas to a gas utility that distributes the gas to the public. 18 SECTION 4. Section 104.2545, Utilities Code, is amended by 19 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 20 21 (e) This section does not apply to a propane utility. SECTION 5. Section 104.258, Utilities Code, is amended to 22 23 read as follows: 24 Sec. 104.258. DISCONNECTION OF NATURAL GAS OR PROPANE GAS 25 SERVICE. (a) In this section: (1) "Extreme weather emergency" means a period during 26 27 which the previous day's highest temperature did not exceed 32

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degrees Fahrenheit and the temperature is predicted to remain at or
below that level for the next 24 hours according to the nearest
National Weather Service reports.

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(2) "Provider" means:

5 (A) a gas utility, as defined by Sections 101.0036 and 121.001; [and]

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(A-1) a propane utility, as defined by Section 101.003; and

9 (B) an owner, operator, or manager of a mobile 10 home park or apartment who purchases natural gas <u>or propane gas</u> 11 through a master meter for delivery to a dwelling unit in a mobile 12 home park or apartment house under Chapter 124.

(b) A provider may not disconnect natural gas <u>or propane gas</u> service to a residential customer on a weekend day unless personnel of the provider are available on that day to take payments and reconnect service.

17 (c) A provider may not disconnect natural gas <u>or propane gas</u> 18 service to a residential customer during an extreme weather 19 emergency. The provider shall defer collection of the full payment 20 of bills that are due during an extreme weather emergency until 21 after the emergency is over and shall work with customers to 22 establish a pay schedule for deferred bills.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
