## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the qualifications for certification of a person as a
3	qualified business under the enterprise zone program.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2303.402, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) In this section, "emerging technology" means:
9	(1) semiconductors;
10	(2) information and computer technology;
11	(3) micro-electromechanical systems;
12	(4) manufactured energy systems;
13	(5) nanotechnology; and
14	(6) biotechnology.
15	(b) A person is a qualified business if the bank, for the
16	purpose of state benefits under this chapter, or the nominating
17	body of a project or activity of the person under this chapter, for
18	the purpose of local incentives, certifies that:
19	(1) the person is engaged in or has provided
20	substantial commitment to initiate the active conduct of a trade or
21	business in an enterprise zone, and:
22	(A) if the trade or business is an emerging
23	technology trade or business, at least 25 percent of the person's
24	new employees in the enterprise zone are economically disadvantaged

- 2 (B) if the trade or business is not an emerging
- 3 technology trade or business, at least 25 percent of the person's
- 4 new employees in the enterprise zone are:
- $(i) [\frac{A}{A}]$  residents of any enterprise zone
- 6 in this state; or
- 7  $\underline{\text{(ii)}} [ \frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}} ]$  economically disadvantaged
- 8 individuals; or
- 9 (2) the person is engaged in or has provided
- 10 substantial commitment to initiate the active conduct of a trade or
- 11 business in an area of this state that does not qualify as an
- 12 enterprise zone, and:
- 13 (A) if the trade or business is an emerging
- 14 technology trade or business, at least 35 percent of the person's
- 15 new employees at the qualified business site are individuals who
- 16 are economically disadvantaged; or
- 17 (B) if the trade or business is not an emerging
- 18 technology trade or business, at least 35 percent of the person's
- 19 new employees at the qualified business site are:
- (i)  $[\frac{A}{A}]$  residents of any enterprise zone
- 21 in this state; or
- $\underline{\text{(ii)}}$  [\frac{\lambda}{B}\] individuals who are
- 23 economically disadvantaged.
- 24 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 25 2303.402, Government Code, apply only to an application for a
- 26 designation under the enterprise zone program under Chapter 2303,
- 27 Government Code, as amended by this Act, that is filed on or after

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- 1 the effective date of this Act. An application for a designation
- 2 under the enterprise zone program that is filed before the
- 3 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 4 date the application was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 5 effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
