## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to curriculum requirements for the recommended and
3	advanced public high school programs.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.025(b-1), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(b-1) The State Board of Education by rule shall require
8	that:
9	(1) [except as provided by Subsection (b-2),
10	curriculum requirements for the recommended and advanced high
11	school programs under Subsection (a) include a requirement that
12	students successfully complete:
13	(A) a science and mathematics curriculum that
14	prescribes, among other requirements established by the board,
15	successful completion of four courses in mathematics and four
16	courses in science, from among courses approved for each subject by
17	the board [of the foundation curriculum under Section
18	<del>28.002(a)(1)</del> ];
19	(B) a career and technology curriculum
20	that prescribes, among other requirements established by the
21	board, successful completion of four career and technology courses,
22	three courses in mathematics, and three courses in science, from
23	among courses approved for each subject by the board; or
24	(C) a humanities curriculum that prescribes,

- 1 among other requirements established by the board, successful
- 2 completion of:
- 3 <u>(i) courses in English language arts</u>,
- 4 social studies, languages other than English, and fine arts, from
- 5 among courses approved for each subject by the board; and
- 6 (ii) three courses in mathematics and three
- 7 courses in science from among courses approved for each subject by
- 8 the board; and
- 9 (2) one or more courses offered in the required
- 10 curriculum for the recommended and advanced high school programs
- 11 include a research writing component.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 28.025(b-2), Education Code, is
- 13 repealed.
- 14 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2010, the State Board
- of Education shall adopt rules as required by Section 28.025(b-1),
- 16 Education Code, as amended by this Act. The rules shall provide
- 17 that the curriculum requirements for the recommended and advanced
- 18 high school programs adopted under that subsection apply to a
- 19 student regardless of the school year in which the student entered
- 20 the ninth grade.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
