A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to estimating the rate of growth of the state's economy for

- 3 purposes of the constitutional spending limit.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 316.002(b), (c), and (e), Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) <u>In determining</u> [Except as provided by Subsection (c),
- 8 the board shall determine] the estimated rate of growth of the
- 9 state's economy, the board shall consider the estimated rate of
- 10 growth of the Texas gross state product and the estimated rate of
- 11 growth in Texas total personal income.
- 12 <u>(c)</u> The board shall determine the estimated rate of growth
- 13 of the Texas gross state product by dividing the estimated Texas
- 14 gross state product for the next biennium by the estimated Texas
- 15 gross state product for the current biennium. In determining the
- 16 estimated Texas gross state product for a biennium the board shall
- 17 consider information and analysis provided by the Bureau of
- 18 Economic Analysis of the United States Department of Commerce or
- 19 its successor in function and by other sources the board considers
- 20 reliable. The board shall determine the estimated rate of growth in
- 21 <u>Texas total personal income</u> by dividing the estimated Texas total
- 22 personal income for the next biennium by the estimated Texas total
- 23 personal income for the current biennium. Using standard
- 24 statistical methods, the board shall make the personal income

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- 1 estimate by projecting through the biennium the estimated Texas
- 2 total personal income reported by the United States Department of
- 3 Commerce or its successor in function. The board shall adopt the
- 4 lesser of those two rates as the estimated rate of growth of the
- 5 state's economy.
- 6 [(c) If a more comprehensive definition of the rate of
- 7 growth of the state's economy is developed and is approved by the
- 8 committee established by Section 316.005, the board may use that
- 9 definition in calculating the limit on appropriations.
- 10 (e) In the absence of an action by the Legislative Budget
- 11 Board to adopt a spending limit as provided in Subsections (a),
- 12 [and] (b), and (c), the estimated rate of growth in the state's
- 13 economy from the current biennium to the next biennium shall be
- 14 treated as if it were zero, and the amount of state tax revenues not
- 15 dedicated by the constitution that could be appropriated within the
- 16 limit established by the estimated rate of growth in the state's
- 17 economy shall be the same as the level of appropriations for the
- 18 current biennium.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 in relation to appropriations made for the state fiscal biennium
- 21 beginning September 1, 2011, and subsequent state fiscal bienniums.
- 22 Appropriations for the state fiscal biennium that begins September
- 23 1, 2009, are governed by Subchapter A, Chapter 316, Government
- 24 Code, as it existed on January 1, 2009, and the former law is
- 25 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
