2 relating to persons authorized to make payroll deductions for 3 county employees.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 155.021, Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 155.021. DEDUCTIONS ENUMERATED. The county 8 treasurer, a county employee or office assigned by the 9 <u>commissioners court to prepare payroll</u>, or, if another officer is 10 specified by law, that other officer shall make the deductions 11 from, or take other similar actions with regard to, the 12 compensation of county employees as required:

13 (1) for employee contributions for coverage under the 14 federal social security program in accordance with Chapter 606, 15 Government Code;

16 (2) for the purchase of annuities or for contributions 17 to investments for employees in accordance with Chapter 22, Acts of 18 the 57th Legislature, 3rd Called Session, 1962 (Article 6228a-5, 19 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes);

20 (3) for the purchase of United States savings bonds 21 for employees in accordance with Chapter <u>608</u> [606], Government 22 Code;

(4) for employee participation in a deferred
compensation plan in accordance with Chapter 609, Government Code;

2 (5) for employee contributions to a retirement system
3 in accordance with Section 845.403, Government Code.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
