- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 92.016, Property Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 92.016. RIGHT TO VACATE AND AVOID LIABILITY FOLLOWING
- 9 CERTAIN CRIMINAL OFFENSES OR FAMILY VIOLENCE.
- SECTION 2. Sections 92.016(b) and (f), Property Code, are
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (b) A tenant may terminate the tenant's rights and
- 13 obligations under a lease [and may vacate the dwelling] and avoid
- 14 liability for future rent and any other sums due under the lease for
- 15 terminating the lease [and vacating the dwelling] before the end of
- 16 the lease term <u>beginning</u> on the <u>date after</u> [<u>if</u>] the tenant <u>vacates</u>
- 17 the premises [complies with Subsection (c) and obtains] and
- 18 provides the landlord or the landlord's agent a copy of:
- 19 <u>(1) if the tenant is a victim of an offense under</u>
- 20 Chapter 20, 21, 22, 28, 29, 30, or 31, Penal Code, that took place on
- 21 the premises or at any dwelling on the premises, an official law
- 22 enforcement report of the offense; or
- (2) if the tenant or occupant is the victim of family
- 24 violence under Section 71.004, Family Code, one or more of the

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- 1 following orders protecting the tenant or an occupant from family
- 2 violence committed by a cotenant or occupant of the dwelling:
- 3 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{\lambda(1)}{\lambda}] a temporary injunction issued under
- 4 Subchapter F, Chapter 6, Family Code; or
- 5 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ a protective order issued under
- 6 Chapter 85, Family Code.
- 7 (f) A tenant who terminates a lease under Subsection (b) is
- 8 released from all liability for any delinquent, unpaid rent owed to
- 9 the landlord by the tenant on the effective date of the lease
- 10 termination if the lease does not contain language substantially
- 11 equivalent to the following:
- "Tenants may have special statutory rights to
- 13 terminate the lease early in certain situations
- involving <u>certain criminal offenses</u>, family violence,
- or a military deployment or transfer."
- SECTION 3. Section 92.016(c), Property Code, is repealed.
- 17 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a lease that is executed or renewed on or after the effective
- 19 date of this Act. A lease that is executed or renewed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 21 time the lease was executed or renewed, and that law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
