A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the appointment and removal of appraisal review board
- 3 members.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 6.41(d), (e), and (f), Tax Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Members of the board are appointed by the county judge
- 8 of the county in which the appraisal district is established
- 9 [resolution of a majority of the appraisal district board of
- 10 directors]. A vacancy on the board is filled in the same manner for
- 11 the unexpired portion of the term.
- 12 (e) Members of the board hold office for terms of two years
- 13 beginning January 1. The appraisal district board of directors by
- 14 resolution shall provide for staggered terms, so that the terms of
- 15 as close to one-half of the members as possible expire each year.
- 16 In making the initial or subsequent appointments, the county judge
- 17 of the county in which the appraisal district is established [board
- 18 of directors] shall designate those members who serve terms of one
- 19 year as needed to comply with this subsection.
- 20 (f) A member of the board may be removed from the board by
- 21 the county judge of the county in which [a majority vote of] the
- 22 appraisal district is established [board of directors]. Grounds
- 23 for removal are:
- 24 (1) a violation of Section 6.412, 6.413, 41.66(f), or

- 1 41.69; or
- 2 (2) good cause relating to the attendance of members
- 3 at called meetings of the board as established by written policy
- 4 adopted by a majority of the appraisal district board of directors.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act, the county judge of each county in which
- 7 an appraisal district is established shall in the manner provided
- 8 by Section 6.41, Tax Code, as amended by this Act, appoint the
- 9 members of the appraisal review board for the district. In making
- 10 the initial appointments, the county judge shall designate those
- 11 members who serve terms of one year.
- 12 (b) The term of an appraisal review board member serving on
- 13 December 31, 2009, expires on January 1, 2010.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
