2	relating to a provisional license for convalescent and nursing home

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.0337 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 242.0337. PROVISIONAL LICENSE. (a) The department by
8	rule shall establish procedures to issue a six-month provisional
9	license to a newly constructed facility, including a newly
10	constructed facility intended to replace an existing or previously
11	operating facility. The department may issue a provisional license
12	under this subsection only if:
13	(1) the facility is in compliance with resident care
14	standards;
15	(2) the facility meets all life safety code and
16	<pre>physical plant requirements;</pre>
17	(3) all local approvals have been obtained;
18	(4) a complete license application is submitted within
19	30 days of the receipt of all local approvals; and
20	(5) the license fee has been paid.
21	(b) The department by rule shall establish procedures to
22	issue a 90-day provisional license to a facility that holds an
23	unexpired temporary change of ownership license under Section
24	242.0336. The provisional license shall take effect on the date the

- 1 temporary change of ownership license expires.
- 2 <u>(c)</u> The department shall issue a license under Section
- 3 242.033 to a facility after the provisional license expires if the
- 4 department determines that the facility meets the requirements
- 5 under Section 242.033.
- 6 (d) The department shall adopt rules to implement this
- 7 section.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 242.034(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (e) The applicable license fee must be paid with each
- 11 application for a probationary license, an initial license, a
- 12 renewal license, a provisional license for a newly constructed
- 13 <u>facility under Section 242.0337(a)</u>, or a <u>temporary</u> change of
- 14 ownership license under Section 242.0336.
- 15 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2010, the executive
- 16 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 17 adopt the rules required by Section 242.0337, Health and Safety
- 18 Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 242.0337, Health and Safety Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, applies to an application for a provisional
- 21 license submitted on or after January 1, 2010.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
