A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the criminal consequences of a failure to pay the
- 3 surcharge assessed on a person's driver's license under the driver
- 4 responsibility program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 708.152, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) A person commits an offense if the person fails to pay or
- 9 enter into an installment payment agreement with the department to
- 10 pay the amount of a surcharge on the person's license. Each failure
- 11 to pay or enter into an agreement to pay the amount of a surcharge is
- 12 <u>a separate offense.</u> An offense under this subsection is a
- 13 misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a surcharge that is assessed by the Texas Department of Public
- 16 Safety on a person's driver's license on or after the effective date
- 17 of this Act. A surcharge that was assessed on a person's driver's
- 18 license before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law
- 19 in effect when the Texas Department of Public Safety assessed the
- 20 surcharge, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
