- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 548.053, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) If an inspection discloses the necessity for
- 8 adjustment, correction, or repair and if the inspection station is
- 9 in the business of making those adjustments, corrections, or
- 10 repairs, the owner or operator of the vehicle is entitled to an
- 11 estimate of the cost, including the cost of all parts and labor,
- 12 that the inspection station would charge to make the needed
- 13 <u>adjustment</u>, correction, or repair. The inspection station may not
- 14 charge the owner or operator for an adjustment, correction, or
- 15 repair that is not specifically authorized in advance by the owner
- 16 or <u>operator</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 548.501, Transportation Code, is amended
- 18 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) An inspection station may collect the applicable
- 20 inspection fee at the time of the original inspection of a vehicle,
- 21 regardless of whether an inspection certificate is issued at that
- 22 time. An inspection fee may be included with charges for other
- 23 products or services but must be shown on a work order for the
- 24 products or services as a separate item. An inspection fee may be

- 1 advertised in conjunction with other products or services.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
