## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of railroad quiet zones outside the boundaries of certain municipalities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 311, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 311.054 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 311.054. RAILROAD QUIET ZONE LOCATED OUTSIDE TYPE A GENERAL-LAW MUNICIPALITY. (a) This section applies only to a Type 8 9 A general-law municipality that is an enclave surrounded entirely by a municipality with a population of 1.1 million or more. 10 11 (b) The governing body of the general-law municipality may enter into an interlocal contract with the surrounding municipality 12 for the establishment of a railroad quiet zone located outside the 13 boundaries of the general-law municipality that the governing body 14 determines will benefit the general-law municipality. 15 16 (c) A general-law municipality may expend municipal funds and may issue certificates of obligation or bonds to pay for 17 expenses associated with a railroad quiet zone under Subsection 18 (b), including expenses related to feasibility, engineering, and 19 traffic studies and improvements related to the railroad quiet 20 21 zone.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
