A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the required use of tax increment financing to provide
- 3 affordable housing in certain reinvestment zones.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 311.011, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) This subsection applies only to a zone that is located
- 8 in a county with a population of more than 800,000 and less than 1.4
- 9 million, is designated on or after January 1, 2005, and is or will
- 10 be served by a rail transportation project as defined by Section
- 11 311.01005. The project plan for the zone must:
- 12 (1) contain a residential component that includes the
- 13 construction of affordable housing in the zone;
- 14 (2) require that at least 25 percent of the tax
- 15 increment of the zone be used to acquire necessary real property and
- 16 construct the affordable housing until at least 10 percent of the
- 17 total square footage in the residential component as shown in the
- 18 project plan consists of multifamily rental properties and
- 19 single-family dwellings, half of which are affordable to
- 20 individuals or families with incomes at or below 30 percent of the
- 21 area median income, as determined by the Texas Department of
- 22 Housing and Community Affairs, adjusted for family size, and half
- 23 of which are affordable to individuals or families with incomes
- 24 above 30 percent and below 50 percent of the adjusted area median

- 1 <u>income</u>;
- 2 (3) require that the affordable housing consisting of
- 3 rental properties continue to be affordable for at least 30 years
- 4 from the date of construction and that the affordable housing
- 5 consisting of owner-occupied single-family dwellings continue to
- 6 be affordable for at least 10 years from the date of construction;
- 7 and
- 8 (4) include policies that govern the administration of
- 9 the affordability terms for affordable housing consisting of rental
- 10 properties and of owner-occupied single-family dwellings.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
