- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 466.408(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) If a claim is not made for prize money on or before the
- 8 180th day after the date on which the winner was selected, the prize
- 9 money shall be used in the following order of priority:
- 10 (1) subject to legislative appropriation, not more
- 11 than \$20 million in prize money each year may be deposited to or
- 12 appropriated from the [Texas] Department of State Health Services
- 13 state-owned multicategorical teaching hospital account, which is
- 14 an account in the general revenue fund;
- 15 (2) not more than \$5 million in prize money each year
- 16 may be appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission and
- 17 shall be used to support the provision of inpatient hospital
- 18 services in hospitals located in the 15 counties that comprise the
- 19 Texas-Mexico border area, with payment for those services to be not
- 20 less than the amount established under the Tax Equity and Fiscal
- 21 Responsibility Act of 1982 (TEFRA) cost reimbursement methodology
- 22 for the hospital providing the services; and
- 23 (3) all prize money subject to this section and not
- 24 appropriated <u>in accordance with</u> [from the Texas Department of

- 1 Health state-owned multicategorical teaching hospital account or
- 2 not appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission for
- 3 the purpose specified in] Subdivision (1) or (2) shall be deposited
- 4 in the Texas rail relocation and improvement fund created under
- 5 Section 49-o, Article III, Texas Constitution, and may be used only
- 6 as provided by that section [general revenue fund and may be
- 7 appropriated for any purpose as determined by the legislature,
- 8 including the provision of indigent health care services as
- 9 specified in Chapter 61, Health and Safety Code].
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
