- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 95.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (4) to read as follows:
- 7 (4) "Improvement to real property" means a structure or
- 8 part of a structure permanently affixed to or incorporated into
- 9 real property. The term does not include scaffolding, ladders, or
- 10 other temporary structures used in the construction, repair,
- 11 renovation, or modification of the improvement.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 95.003, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 13 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 95.003. LIABILITY FOR ACTS OF INDEPENDENT
- 15 CONTRACTORS. A property owner is not liable for personal injury,
- 16 death, or property damage to a contractor, subcontractor, or an
- 17 employee of a contractor or subcontractor who constructs, repairs,
- 18 renovates, or modifies an improvement to real property, including
- 19 personal injury, death, or property damage arising from the failure
- 20 to provide a safe workplace unless:
- 21 (1) the property owner exercises or retains some
- 22 control over the manner in which the work is performed, other than
- 23 the right to order the work to start or stop or to inspect progress

- 1 (2) the property owner <u>created or</u> had actual <u>or</u>
- 2 <u>constructive</u> knowledge of the danger or condition resulting in the
- 3 personal injury, death, or property damage and failed to correct or
- 4 adequately warn of the danger or condition.
- 5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 7 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 8 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 9 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
