4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 466.027 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 466.027. VETERANS' ASSISTANCE GAME. (a) The
8	commission shall operate an instant-ticket lottery game to benefit
9	the fund for veterans' assistance established by Section 434.017,
10	as amended by Chapter 1418 (H.B. 3107), Acts of the 80th
11	Legislature, Regular Session, 2007.
12	(b) The commission shall:
13	(1) determine the ticket price, payout amounts, and
14	manner in which the game is conducted;
15	(2) make tickets to the game available for sale
16	continuously to the extent practicable; and
17	(3) change the design or theme of the game regularly to
18	ensure that the game remains competitive with other instant-ticket
19	lottery games offered by the commission.

- 10 (1) subject to legislative appropriation, not more
- 11 than \$20 million in prize money each year may be deposited to or
- 12 appropriated from the Texas Department of Health state-owned
- 13 multicategorical teaching hospital account, which is an account in
- 14 the general revenue fund;
- 15 (2) not more than \$5 million in prize money each year
- 16 may be appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission and
- 17 shall be used to support the provision of inpatient hospital
- 18 services in hospitals located in the 15 counties that comprise the
- 19 Texas-Mexico border area, with payment for those services to be not
- 20 less than the amount established under the Tax Equity and Fiscal
- 21 Responsibility Act of 1982 (TEFRA) cost reimbursement methodology
- 22 for the hospital providing the services; [and]
- 23 (3) the remaining amount, not to exceed \$5 million in
- 24 prize money in each state fiscal year less any amount deposited in
- 25 the fund in that year attributable to the lottery game operated
- 26 under Section 466.027, shall be deposited to the fund for veterans'
- 27 assistance; and

- 1 (4) all prize money subject to this section and not appropriated from the Texas Department of Health state-owned 2 3 multicategorical teaching hospital account, [orderight] not appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission for the purpose 4 specified in Subdivision (2), and not deposited under Subdivision 5 (3), shall be deposited in the general revenue fund and may be 6 appropriated for any purpose as determined by the legislature, 7 8 including the provision of indigent health care services as specified in Chapter 61, Health and Safety Code. 9
- SECTION 6. Sections 434.017(a) and (e), Government Code, as amended by Chapter 1418 (H.B. 3107), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The fund for veterans' assistance is a special fund in 14 the state treasury outside the general revenue fund. The fund is 15 composed of:
- 16 (1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of the legislature;
- 18 (2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund; [and]
- 19 (3) the earnings of the fund; and
- 20 (4) money transferred to the fund from proceeds of the
  21 lottery game operated under Section 466.027 or transferred to the
  22 fund under Section 466.408(b).
- (e) The <u>commission</u> [<u>comptroller</u>] may solicit, [<u>and</u>] accept, or refuse a gift or grant of money, services, or property for any purpose related to the fund for veterans' assistance [gifts and grants to the fund]. A gift or grant to the fund may be appropriated in the same manner as other money in the fund, subject to any

- 1 limitation or requirement placed on the gift or grant by the donor
- 2 or granting entity.
- 3 SECTION 7. (a) Sections 1 and 3 of this Act take effect only
- 4 if the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, relating
- 5 to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes
- 6 does not become law.
- 7 (b) Sections 2 and 4 of this Act take effect only if the Act
- 8 of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, relating to
- 9 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes
- 10 becomes law.
- 11 SECTION 8. (a) Section 466.355, Government Code, as
- 12 amended by this Act, applies only to a transfer from the state
- 13 lottery account made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 (b) The Texas Lottery Commission shall establish and begin
- 15 selling tickets to the lottery game as required by Section 466.027,
- 16 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than March 2, 2010.
- 17 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
