- SECTION 1. Section 5.053(a), Water Code, is amended to read 5
- as follows: 6

- 7 A person may not be a member of the commission if the
- person or the person's spouse: 8
- is registered, certified, licensed, permitted, or 9 (1)
- otherwise authorized by the commission; or 10
- 11 [is employed by or participates in the management
- 12 of a business entity or other organization regulated by the
- commission or receiving money from the commission; 13
- 14 [(3) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other 15
- organization regulated by or receiving funds from the commission; 16

- $[\frac{(4)}{1}]$ 18 uses or receives a substantial amount

- 22 SECTION 2. Section 5.054(a), Water Code, is amended to read
- 23 as follows:
- (a) It is a ground for removal from the commission that a 24

- 1 member:
- 2 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 3 qualifications required by Section 5.053(b);
- 4 (2) does not maintain during the service on the
- 5 commission the qualifications required by Section 5.053(b);
- 6 (3) is ineligible for membership under Section
- 7 5.053(a), 5.059, or 5.060;
- 8 (4) cannot, because of illness or disability,
- 9 discharge the member's duties for a substantial part of the member's
- 10 term; [<del>or</del>]
- 11 (5) is absent from more than one-half of the regularly
- 12 scheduled commission meetings that the member is eligible to attend
- 13 during each calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority
- 14 vote of the commission; or
- 15 (6) failed to comply with Section 5.061.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 17 by adding Section 5.061 to read as follows:
- Sec. 5.061. RECUSAL OF COMMISSION MEMBERS. (a) If a
- 19 matter comes before the commission and a member is employed by,
- 20 participates in the management of, or has a substantial financial
- 21 <u>interest in a business entity or other organization that has a</u>
- 22 direct interest in that matter, that member shall:
- (1) disclose the fact of that employment, management,
- 24 or interest to the commission;
- 25 (2) recuse himself or herself from the commission's
- 26 deliberations and actions on the matter; and
- 27 (3) abstain from voting on the matter or otherwise

- 1 participating in a decision on the matter.
- 2 (b) The fact that a member is recused from a vote or decision
- 3 by application of this section does not affect the existence of a
- 4 quorum.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 5.053(c), Water Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
