- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.43, Tax Code, is amended by amending
- 6 Subsection (j) and adding Subsection (n) to read as follows:
- 7 (j) An application for an exemption under Section 11.13
- 8 must:
- 9 (1) list each owner of the residence homestead and the
- 10 interest of each owner;
- 11 (2) state that the applicant does not claim an
- 12 exemption under that section on another residence homestead;
- 13 (3) state that each fact contained in the application
- 14 is true; [and]
- 15 (4) include a copy of the applicant's driver's license
- 16 or state-issued personal identification certificate and a copy of
- 17 the applicant's vehicle registration receipt; and
- 18 <u>(5)</u> include a sworn statement that the applicant has
- 19 read and understands the notice of the penalties required by
- 20 Subsection (f).
- 21 (n) A chief appraiser may not allow an exemption provided by
- 22 <u>Section 11.13 unless:</u>
- 23 <u>(1) the address on the driver's license or</u>
- 24 state-issued personal identification certificate provided by the

- 1 applicant under Subsection (j) corresponds to the address on the
- 2 applicant's vehicle registration receipt provided under that
- 3 subsection; and
- 4 (2) the address indicated in Subdivision (1)
- 5 corresponds to the address of the property for which the exemption
- 6 is claimed.
- 7 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an application for a residence homestead exemption filed with a
- 9 chief appraiser on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 10 application for a residence homestead exemption filed with a chief
- 11 appraiser before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 12 law in effect when the application was filed, and the former law is
- 13 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
