Section 419.038, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 7 follows: 8 9 (a) The commission shall adopt requirements for certification of aircraft fire fighting and rescue fire protection 10 personnel. A person may not be appointed to an aircraft fire 11 12 fighting and rescue fire protection personnel position, except on a probationary basis, unless the person: 13 14 (1) has completed the training prescribed by the commission; or 15 (2) meets the requirements of Subsection (d). 16 (d) A person is considered to have satisfied the training 17 requirements of this section and may be appointed to an aircraft 18 fire fighting and rescue fire protection personnel position if the 19 person is employed at an airport that: 20 21 (1) is classified as a Class IV airport under 14 C.F.R. 22 Part 139; and 23 (2) holds an Airport Operating Certificate issued 24 under 14 C.F.R. Part 139.

1 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to 2 aircraft fire fighting and rescue fire protection personnel 3 appointed under Section 419.038, Government Code, without regard to 4 whether the personnel were appointed on, before, or after the 5 effective date of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
