A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the diabetes mellitus registry pilot program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 1(c), (d), and (e), Chapter 706 (H.B.
- 5 2132), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The department shall select to participate in the pilot
- 8 program a public health district that serves a county with a
- 9 population of less than two million and contains a municipality
- 10 with a population of over one million. The department and the
- 11 public health district shall create an electronic registry to track
- 12 the glycosylated hemoglobin level <u>and the diagnosis codes</u> of each
- 13 person who has a laboratory test to determine that level performed
- 14 at a clinical laboratory in the district.
- 15 (d) A physician practicing [clinical laboratory located] in
- 16 the participating public health district shall submit to the
- 17 district and the department the results of each glycosylated
- 18 hemoglobin test that the physician orders for a patient, along with
- 19 the diagnosis codes for the patient, if the patient consents, in
- 20 writing, to the submission of the information [laboratory
- 21 performs].
- (e) The department and the participating public health
- 23 district shall:
- 24 (1) compile results submitted under Subsection (d) of

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- 1 this section in order to track:
- 2 (A) the prevalence of diabetes mellitus among
- 3 people tested in the district;
- 4 (B) the level of diabetic control for the
- 5 patients with diabetes mellitus in each demographic group [exert
- 6 over the diabetes mellitus];
- 7 (C) the trends of new diagnoses of diabetes
- 8 mellitus in the district; and
- 9 (D) the health care costs associated with
- 10 diabetes mellitus and glycosylated hemoglobin testing; and
- 11 (2) promote discussion and public information
- 12 programs regarding diabetes mellitus.
- SECTION 2. Section 2, Chapter 706 (H.B. 2132), Acts of the
- 14 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is amended to read as
- 15 follows:
- Sec. 2. RULES. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 17 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section 1
- 18 of this Act, including rules to govern the format and method of
- 19 collecting glycosylated hemoglobin data and patient diagnosis
- 20 codes.
- SECTION 3. Section 4, Chapter 706 (H.B. 2132), Acts of the
- 22 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is amended to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 4. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2010 [$\frac{2009}{1}$], the
- 25 Department of State Health Services shall submit a report to the
- 26 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 27 representatives, and appropriate standing committees of the

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- 1 legislature regarding the diabetes mellitus <u>registry</u> pilot program
- 2 that includes:
- 3 (1) an evaluation of the effectiveness of the pilot
- 4 program; and
- 5 (2) a recommendation to continue, expand, or eliminate
- 6 the pilot program.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 5, Chapter 706 (H.B. 2132), Acts of the
- 8 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is amended to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 Sec. 5. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2011
- 11 $[\frac{2010}{}]$.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
