5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 37.0181 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 37.0181. STAFF DEVELOPMENT REGARDING DISCIPLINARY
8	PROCEDURES. (a) Each teacher and each principal or other
9	appropriate administrator who oversees student discipline shall
10	attend staff development training designed to assist the teacher or
11	the principal or other administrator in determining methods for
12	incorporating appropriate discipline management techniques
13	consistent with the student code of conduct adopted under Section
14	37.001 by the school district employing the teacher or the
15	principal or other administrator.
16	(b) Staff development training under this section must

18	(1) specific information relating to appropriate
19	methods for applying the provisions of this chapter; and

- 7 SECTION 2. Section 21.453(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) The staff development account is an account in the
- 10 general revenue fund. The account consists of gifts, grants,
- 11 donations, appropriations for the purpose of staff development
- 12 under this subchapter and Section 37.0181, and any other money
- 13 transferred by law to the account. Funds in the account may be used
- 14 only as provided by this section.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
