- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 49, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER C. DUTIES PERFORMED BY MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES
- 8 Art. 49.51. POWERS AND DUTIES. A judge of a municipal court
- 9 may conduct an inquest under this chapter into the death of a person
- 10 who dies in the municipality served by the judge to the same extent
- 11 a justice of the peace serving the precinct in which the body or
- 12 body part was found may conduct an inquest under Subchapter A into
- 13 the death of that person. The municipal court judge may exercise
- 14 any power granted to, and shall perform any duty imposed on, the
- 15 justice of the peace by Subchapter A or another law relating to
- 16 inquests conducted by a justice of the peace.
- 17 SECTION 2. Article 49.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 18 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 19 (c-1) A person who is required by this subchapter to give
- 20 notice to a justice of the peace or county judge may instead give
- 21 notice to a judge of a municipal court in the municipality in which
- 22 the body or body part was found.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
