2	relating to the licensing and regulation of landmen by the Texas

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1101.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as follows:
7	(3-a) "Landman" means a person who, in the course and
8	scope of the person's business:
9	(A) acquires or manages petroleum, natural gas,
10	or mineral interests;
11	(B) performs title or contract functions related
12	to the exploration, exploitation, or disposition of petroleum,
13	natural gas, or mineral interests;

- 14 (C) negotiates for the acquisition or
- divestiture of petroleum, natural gas, or mineral rights, including 15
- the acquisition or divestiture of land or petroleum, natural gas, 16
- or mineral rights for a pipeline; or 17
- (D) negotiates business agreements that provide 18
- 19 for the exploration for or development of petroleum, natural gas,
- 20 or minerals.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 1101.005, Occupations Code, is amended
- to read as follows: 22
- 23 Sec. 1101.005. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
- 24 does not apply to:

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- 1 (1) an attorney licensed in any state;
- 2 (2) an attorney-in-fact authorized under a power of
- 3 attorney to conduct a real estate transaction;
- 4 (3) a public official while engaged in official
- 5 duties;
- 6 (4) an auctioneer licensed under Chapter 1802 while
- 7 conducting the sale of real estate by auction if the auctioneer does
- 8 not perform another act of a broker or salesperson;
- 9 (5) a person conducting a real estate transaction
- 10 under a court order or the authority of a will or written trust
- 11 instrument;
- 12 (6) a person employed by an owner in the sale of
- 13 structures and land on which structures are located if the
- 14 structures are erected by the owner in the course of the owner's
- 15 business;
- 16 (7) an on-site manager of an apartment complex;
- 17 (8) an owner or the owner's employee who leases the
- 18 owner's improved or unimproved real estate;
- 19 (9) a partnership or limited liability partnership
- 20 acting as a broker or salesperson through a partner who is a
- 21 licensed broker; or
- 22 (10) a transaction involving:
- 23 (A) the sale, lease, or transfer of a mineral or
- 24 mining interest in real property subject to Section 1101.3515;
- 25 (B) the sale, lease, or transfer of a cemetery
- 26 lot;
- (C) the lease or management of a hotel or motel;

- 2 (D) the sale of real property under a power of
- 3 sale conferred by a deed of trust or other contract lien.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter H, Chapter 1101, Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 1101.3515 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1101.3515. LANDMAN LICENSE REQUIRED. (a) A person may
- 7 not act as or represent that the person is a landman in this state
- 8 unless the person holds a landman license under this chapter.
- 9 (b) An applicant for a landman license shall submit an
- 10 application to the commission on the form prescribed by the
- 11 commission, pay the fee established by commission rule, and comply
- 12 with any other requirements established by commission rule,
- 13 including eligibility and examination requirements. An applicant
- 14 for a landman license may not act as a landman until the person
- 15 receives a license issued by the commission.
- 16 (c) To protect the public, the commission by rule shall:
- 17 (1) establish the eligibility requirements for a
- 18 landman license holder, including education, experience, and
- 19 examination requirements as appropriate;
- 20 (2) establish the moral character requirements,
- 21 <u>including honesty</u>, trustworthiness, and integrity, an applicant or
- 22 <u>license holder must satisfy to hold a landman license;</u>
- 23 (3) establish the form and procedures for applying for
- 24 a landman license;
- 25 (4) set the application and license fees;
- 26 (5) establish the term of the license and renewal
- 27 <u>procedures</u> and fees;

- 1 (6) establish continuing education requirements;
- 2 (7) determine the scope of practice by a landman
- 3 license holder; and
- 4 (8) require a landman license holder to comply with
- 5 the standards of conduct and ethics established by the commission
- 6 for a person licensed under this chapter.
- 7 (d) A landman license is valid for the term established by
- 8 commission rule. A landman may renew a landman license by
- 9 submitting a renewal application to the commission on the form
- 10 prescribed by the commission, paying the required renewal fee, and
- 11 complying with any other requirements established by commission
- 12 rule, including continuing education requirements.
- 13 (e) A licensed landman or person required to be licensed as
- 14 a landman who violates this chapter or rules adopted under this
- 15 chapter is subject to disciplinary action under this chapter.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the Texas
- 17 Real Estate Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 18 Section 1101.3515, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 (b) Notwithstanding Section 1101.3515, Occupations Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, a person is not required to hold a landman
- 21 license to act as a landman in this state until March 1, 2010.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
