A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the state contribution to and certain annuities under
- 3 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 824.203(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (c) and (d), the
- 8 standard service retirement annuity is an amount computed on the
- 9 basis of the member's average annual compensation for the three
- 10 [five] years of service, whether or not consecutive, in which the
- 11 member received the highest annual compensation, times 2.3 percent
- 12 for each year of service credit in the retirement system.
- SECTION 2. Section 825.404(a), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) During each fiscal year, the state shall contribute to
- 16 the retirement system an amount equal to at least seven [six and not
- 17 more than 10] percent of the aggregate annual compensation of all
- 18 members of the retirement system during that fiscal year. The
- 19 amount of the state contribution made under this section may not be
- 20 less than the amount contributed by members during that fiscal year
- 21 in accordance with Section 825.402. The state may contribute a
- 22 higher amount specified in the General Appropriations Act but may
- 23 not contribute more than 10 percent of the aggregate annual
- 24 compensation of all members of the retirement system during that

1 fiscal year.

- 2 SECTION 3. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 824.203(a) and
- 3 (b), Government Code, and subject to Section 821.006, Government
- 4 Code, the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of
- 5 Texas shall recompute the amount of a standard service retirement
- 6 annuity under Chapter 824, Government Code, by applying a one-time
- 7 four percent increase to the monthly amount otherwise required to
- 8 be paid as determined in accordance with Chapter 824, Government
- 9 Code, including the amount of any previous increase made under
- 10 other law.
- 11 (b) An increase under Subsection (a) of this section is
- 12 payable beginning on September 1, 2009.
- 13 (c) An increase under Subsection (a) of this section is
- 14 payable without regard to any forfeiture of benefits under Section
- 15 824.601, Government Code.
- 16 (d) To be eligible for an increase under Subsection (a) of
- 17 this section, a person must be, for the month of August 2009, and
- 18 disregarding any forfeiture of benefits under Section 824.601,
- 19 Government Code, an annuitant eligible to receive:
- 20 (1) a standard retirement annuity payment; or
- 21 (2) an optional retirement annuity payment as either a
- 22 retiree or beneficiary.
- (e) Except as provided by this section, the board of
- 24 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall determine
- 25 the eligibility for an increase under Subsection (a) of this
- 26 section.
- SECTION 4. Section 824.203(a), Government Code, as amended

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- 1 by this Act, applies only to a person who retires from the Teacher
- 2 Retirement System of Texas on or after the effective date of this
- 3 Act. A person who retires from the Teacher Retirement System of
- 4 Texas before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 5 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 6 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 5. Section 825.404(a), Government Code, as amended
- 8 by this Act, applies beginning with the fiscal year that begins
- 9 September 1, 2009.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
