- 2 relating to records of certain frivolous complaints maintained by

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1071.204(e), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) For any complaint determined to be frivolous or without
- 8 merit, the complaint and other enforcement case information related
- 9 to that complaint are confidential. The information may be used
- 10 only by the board or by its employees or agents directly involved in
- 11 the enforcement process for that complaint. The information is not
- 12 subject to discovery, subpoena, or other disclosure [A frivolous
- 13 complaint is public information, except that the license holder's
- 14 name and other personal information shall be redacted].
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
