## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 26.0291(e), Water Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 (e) The commission by rule shall adopt a fee schedule for

8 determining the amount of the fee to be charged. Beginning

9 September 1, 2009, the maximum amount of a fee under this section is

10 \$100,000. On September 1 of each subsequent year, the commission

11 shall adjust the maximum fee amount as necessary to reflect the

12 percentage change during the preceding year in the Consumer Price

Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. City Average, published

14 monthly by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics, or its

15 successor in function. Notwithstanding any adjustment for

16 <u>inflation under this subsection, the</u> [The] amount of the fee may not

17 exceed \$150,000 [\$75,000] for each permit or contract and the

18 The] maximum annual fee under this section for a wastewater

19 discharge or waste treatment facility that holds a water right for

20 the use of water by the facility is \$150,000 [may not exceed

21 \$75,000]. In determining the amount of a fee under this section,

22 the commission may consider:

23 (1) waste discharge permitting factors such as flow

24 volume, toxic pollutant potential, level of traditional pollutant,

- 1 and heat load;
- 2 (2) the designated uses and segment ranking
- 3 classification of the water affected by discharges from the
- 4 permitted facility;
- 5 (3) the expenses necessary to obtain and administer
- 6 the NPDES program;
- 7 (4) the reasonable costs of administering the water
- 8 quality management programs under Section 26.0135; and
- 9 (5) any other reasonable costs necessary to administer
- 10 and enforce a water resource management program reasonably related
- 11 to the activities of the persons required to pay a fee under this
- 12 section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
