4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 13, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 4008 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 4008. RIGHT OF CERTAIN POLICYHOLDERS TO CHOOSE AGENTS
8	Sec. 4008.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "personal
9	insurance" means:
10	(1) a personal automobile insurance policy;
11	(2) a residential property insurance policy;
12	(3) a residential fire and allied lines insurance
13	policy; or
14	(4) a noncommercial insurance policy covering a boat,
15	personal watercraft, snowmobile, or recreational vehicle.
16	Sec. 4008.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
17	applies to an insurance company authorized to engage in the
18	business of personal insurance in this state.
19	Sec. 4008.003. RIGHT TO CHOOSE AGENT. In a form prescribed
20	by the commissioner, an insurance company to which this chapter
21	applies shall notify an insured not later than the 30th day after
22	the date on which the agent who is primarily responsible for
23	administering the insured's policy ceases to be responsible for
24	that policy. At a minimum, the notice must include:

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(1) a statement informing the insured that the insured 1 has the right to select, from a list of available agents, if 2 applicable, the agent who will be primarily responsible for the 3 insured's policy; 4 5 (2) a list of the names, business addresses, and 6 telephone numbers of agents available to administer the insured's account in the insured's geographical area, as defined by rule by 7 8 the commissioner; 9 (3) a description of the procedure by which the 10 insured may select an agent; and (4) the name, office address, and telephone number of 11 12 the agent who will be primarily responsible for administering the insured's policy until the insured selects an agent. 13 14 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that 15 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2010. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 16 17 January 1, 2010, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 18 19 effect for that purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 20

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
