- 2 relating to the joinder of a tax lien transferee in a suit to
- 3 collect a delinquent ad valorem tax.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.06(i), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (i) Except as provided by Section 33.445, a [A] foreclosure
- 8 of a tax lien transferred as provided by this section may not be
- 9 instituted within one year from the date on which the lien is
- 10 recorded in all counties in which the property is located, unless
- 11 the contract between the owner of the property and the transferee
- 12 provides otherwise.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 33, Tax Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Section 33.445 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 33.445. JOINDER OF TAX LIEN TRANSFEREE. (a) A taxing
- 16 unit acting under Section 33.44(a) shall also join each transferee
- of a tax lien against the property that may appear of record under
- 18 <u>Section 32.06.</u> After the joinder, the transferee of the tax lien
- 19 may file its claim and seek foreclosure in the suit for all amounts
- 20 owed the transferee that are secured by the transferred tax lien,
- 21 regardless of when the original transfer of tax lien was recorded or
- 22 whether the original loan secured by the transferred tax lien is
- 23 delinquent. In the alternative, the transferee may pay all taxes,
- 24 penalties, interest, court costs, and attorney's fees owing to the

- 1 taxing unit that filed the foreclosure suit and each other taxing
- 2 unit that is joined.
- 3 (b) In consideration of the payment by the transferee of
- 4 those taxes and charges, each joined taxing unit shall transfer its
- 5 tax lien to the transferee in the form and manner provided by
- 6 Section 32.06(b) and enter its disclaimer in the suit.
- 7 (c) On transfer of all applicable tax liens, the transferee
- 8 may seek to foreclose the tax liens in the pending suit or in any
- 9 other manner provided by Section 32.06, regardless of when the
- 10 original transfer of tax lien was recorded or whether the original
- 11 loan secured by the transferred tax lien is delinquent. The
- 12 foreclosure may include all amounts owed to the transferee,
- 13 including any amount secured by the original transfer of tax lien.
- 14 (d) All liens held by a transferee who is joined under this
- 15 section but fails to act in the manner provided by this section are
- 16 <u>extinguished</u>, and the court's judgment shall reflect the
- 17 extinguishment of those liens.
- SECTION 3. Section 33.445, Tax Code, as added by this Act,
- 19 applies to a suit for foreclosure of an ad valorem tax lien that is
- 20 pending on the effective date of this Act or that is brought on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
