- 2 relating to the offense of cruelty to nonlivestock animals.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 42.092(a), Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subdivision (9) to read as follows:
- 6 (9) "Harass" means to disturb, worry, molest, harry,
- 7 torment, or chase.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 42.092(e), Penal Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (e) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (b)(2)
- 11 or (6) that:
- 12 (1) the animal was discovered on the person's property
- 13 in the act of or after <u>harassing</u>, injuring, or killing the person's
- 14 livestock animals or damaging the person's crops and that the
- 15 person killed or injured the animal at the time of this discovery;
- 16 or
- 17 (2) the person killed or injured the animal within the
- 18 scope of the person's employment as a public servant or in
- 19 furtherance of activities or operations associated with
- 20 electricity transmission or distribution, electricity generation
- 21 or operations associated with the generation of electricity, or
- 22 natural gas delivery.
- 23 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 4 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 5 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
