- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.013(d), Election Code, as added by

- 6 Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) This section does not apply to:
- 8 (1) an election officer in conducting the officer's
- 9 official duties; [or]
- 10 (2) the use of election equipment necessary for the
- 11 conduct of the election; or
- 12 (3) a person who is employed at the location in which a
- 13 polling place is located while the person is acting in the course of
- 14 the person's employment.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
