- 5 SECTION 1. Section 62.0031, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) This section does not apply to:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> the trapping of a raptor for educational or
- 10 sporting purposes as provided by Chapter 49; or
- 11 (2) the capture, trapping, or hunting of a reptile,
- 12 <u>amphibian</u>, or insect.
- 13 <u>(c) The commission may adopt rules governing the safe</u>
- 14 participation in activities described by Subsection (b).
- 15 SECTION 2. Conduct prohibited by Section 62.0031, Parks and
- 16 Wildlife Code, that involves the capture, trapping, or hunting of a
- 17 reptile, amphibian, or insect may not be prosecuted after the
- 18 effective date of this Act. If on the effective date of this Act a
- 19 criminal action is pending for conduct prohibited by Section
- 20 62.0031 and described by this section, the action is dismissed on
- 21 that date. However, a final conviction for conduct prohibited by
- 22 Section 62.0031 and described by this section that exists on the
- 23 effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act.
