A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the distribution of a prescription drug. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 431.401(5), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: "Normal distribution channel" means a chain of 6 (5) custody for a prescription drug, either directly or by drop 7 shipment, from the manufacturer of the prescription drug, the 8 9 manufacturer to the manufacturer's co-licensed product partner, the manufacturer to the manufacturer's third-party logistics 10 provider, or the manufacturer to the manufacturer's exclusive 11 12 distributor, to: (A) a pharmacy to:

- 13 SECTION 2. Section 431.4031, Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 431.4031. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS FOR
- 16 CERTAIN WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTORS. (a) A wholesale distributor that
- 17 distributes prescription drugs that are medical gases or a
- 18 wholesale distributor that is a manufacturer or a third-party
- 19 logistics provider on behalf of a manufacturer is exempt from
- 20 Sections 431.404(a)(5) and (6), (b), and (c), 431.4045(2), 431.405,
- 21 431.407, and 431.408.
- 22 (b) A state agency or a political subdivision of this state
- 23 that distributes prescription drugs using federal or state funding
- 24 to nonprofit health care facilities or local mental health or
- 25 mental retardation authorities for distribution to a pharmacy,
- 26 practitioner, or patient is exempt from Sections 431.405(b),
- 27 431.407, 431.408, 431.412, and 431.413.

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- 1 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 2 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 3 Services Commission shall adopt, modify, or repeal rules as
- 4 necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
