A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to including information on sudden infant death syndrome
- 3 in a resource pamphlet for parents of newborn children.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 161.501(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A hospital, birthing center, physician, nurse midwife,
- 8 or midwife who provides prenatal care to a pregnant woman during
- 9 gestation or at delivery of an infant shall:
- 10 (1) provide the woman and the father of the infant, if
- 11 possible, or another adult caregiver for the infant, with a
- 12 resource pamphlet that includes:
- 13 (A) a list of the names, addresses, and phone
- 14 numbers of professional organizations that provide postpartum
- 15 counseling and assistance to parents relating to postpartum
- 16 depression and other emotional trauma associated with pregnancy and
- 17 parenting;
- 18 (B) information regarding the prevention of
- 19 shaken baby syndrome including:
- 20 (i) techniques for coping with anger caused
- 21 by a crying baby;
- 22 (ii) different methods for preventing a
- 23 person from shaking a newborn, infant, or other young child;
- 24 (iii) the dangerous effects of shaking a

- 1 newborn, infant, or other young child; and
- 2 (iv) the symptoms of shaken baby syndrome
- 3 and who to contact, as recommended by the American Academy of
- 4 Pediatrics, if a parent suspects or knows that a baby has been
- 5 shaken in order to receive prompt medical treatment;
- 6 (C) a list of diseases for which a child is
- 7 required by state law to be immunized and the appropriate schedule
- 8 for the administration of those immunizations; [and]
- 9 (D) the appropriate schedule for follow-up
- 10 procedures for newborn screening; and
- 11 (E) information regarding sudden infant death
- 12 syndrome, including current recommendations for infant sleeping
- 13 conditions to lower the risk of sudden infant death syndrome;
- 14 (2) document in the woman's record that the woman
- 15 received the information described in Subdivision (1); and
- 16 (3) retain the documentation for at least five years
- 17 in the hospital's, birthing center's, physician's, nurse midwife's,
- 18 or midwife's records.
- 19 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2010, the Department of
- 20 State Health Services shall update the resource pamphlet on the
- 21 department's website to include the information about sudden infant
- 22 death syndrome required by Section 161.501, Health and Safety Code,
- 23 as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. A hospital, birthing center, physician, nurse
- 25 midwife, or midwife who provides prenatal care to a pregnant woman
- 26 during gestation or at delivery of an infant is not required to
- 27 provide the updated brochure containing the information about

- 1 sudden infant death syndrome required by Section 161.501, Health
- 2 and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, before March 1, 2010.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
