- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 766, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 766.004 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 766.004. AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEMS. (a) In
- 8 this section:
- 9 (1) "Builder" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 401.003, Property Code.
- 11 (2) "Homeowner" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 12 <u>401.002</u>, Property Code.
- 13 (b) This section does not apply to a state requirement or an
- 14 ordinance or order of a political subdivision adopted before
- 15 January 1, 2009.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a requirement of
- 17 this state or of an ordinance or order of a political subdivision
- 18 that an automatic fire sprinkler system be installed in a new
- 19 <u>one-family or two-family dwelling may not be enforced with respect</u>
- 20 to a dwelling under 7,500 square feet in size. A prospective owner
- 21 of a one-family or two-family dwelling under 7,500 square feet in
- 22 size in a jurisdiction in which an automatic fire sprinkler system
- 23 would otherwise be required to be installed in the home may choose
- 24 whether or not to have the system installed.

- 1 (d) A builder in a jurisdiction in which an automatic fire
- 2 sprinkler system is required to be installed in any new one-family
- 3 or two-family dwelling shall offer a person with whom the builder
- 4 contracts for the construction of a new one-family or two-family
- 5 dwelling under 7,500 square feet in size the option of installing an
- 6 approved automatic fire sprinkler system in accordance with the
- 7 International Residential Code applicable to the construction
- 8 under Section 430.001, Property Code.
- 9 <u>(e) In the event of a conflict between this section and any</u>
- 10 other law, this section controls.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 766.004(d), Health and Safety Code, as
- 12 added by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or
- 13 after September 1, 2011. A contract entered into before that date
- 14 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 15 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
