## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to notice of applications for permits to drill certain gas
3	wells.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 86, Natural Resources
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 86.044 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 86.044. NOTICE OF CERTAIN GAS WELL PERMIT
8	APPLICATIONS. (a) This section applies only to a gas well proposed
9	to be located in a county that:
10	(1) has a population of more than 50,000; and
11	(2) is located wholly or partly above a
12	hydrocarbon-producing geological formation in which during the
13	preceding year the commission issued more than 1,500 drilling
14	permits authorizing wells to be completed.
15	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), on receipt of the
16	first application for a permit to drill a gas well at a drill site,
17	the commission must provide notice of the application by first
18	class mail and, on request, electronically to:
19	(1) the state senator and representative who represent
20	the area in which the well is proposed to be located; and
21	(2) the following, as applicable:
22	(A) if the well is proposed to be located outside
23	the corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
24	municipality:

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1	(i) the member of the commissioners court
2	who represents the county commissioner precinct in which the well
3	is proposed to be located; and
4	(ii) the county judge of the county in which
5	the well is proposed to be located;
6	(B) if the well is proposed to be located in the
7	corporate limits of a municipality, each member of the governing
8	body of the municipality who represents the area in which the well
9	is proposed to be located; or
10	(C) if the well is proposed to be located in the
11	extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, each member of the
12	governing body of the municipality.
13	(c) The commission is not required to provide notice under
14	this section to a person described by Subsection (b) if the person
15	has waived in writing the right to notice under this section.
16	SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an application for a
17	permit to drill a gas well that is filed with the Railroad
18	Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. An
19	application for a permit to drill a gas well that is filed with the
20	commission before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
21	law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act,
22	and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
