Section 181.004, Utilities Code, is amended to 7 read as follows: Sec. 181.004. CONDEMNATION OF PROPERTY. 8 (a) A gas or 9 electric corporation has the right and power to enter on, condemn, 10 and appropriate the land, right-of-way, easement, or other property of any person or corporation. 11 12 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) or other law, a gas 13 corporation may not condemn or appropriate property for a project related to constructing a gathering or transmission pipeline for 14 transporting gas for a single producer in a county that: 15 16 (1) has a population of more than 1.4 million; and (2) is located wholly or partly above 17 а hydrocarbon-producing geological formation in which during the 18 preceding year the Railroad Commission of Texas issued more than 19 2,000 drilling permits authorizing gas wells to be completed. 20 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 181.004, Utilities Code, applies only to a condemnation proceeding 22 23 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A condemnation proceeding filed before the effective date of this Act is subject to 24

1 the law in effect on the date of filing, and that law is continued in
2 effect for that purpose.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
